There will be a second meeting on Tuesday, October 11th from 2:05-3:10 to answer any remaining questions and assist students in completing the application. Completed applications are due to Mrs. Gifford or Ms. Smolskis by 2:05pm Friday, October 21st. No late or incomplete applications will be considered for acceptance into the National Junior Honor Society.
